

TERMS έ CONDITIONS

Please ensure you read and understand the below terms and conditions of entry.

You will be required to sign a similar document upon entry to the Thunderegg Mine at Thunderbird Park.

Warning: The following are just some of the hazards that exist on a mine site:

- Slipping / falling on uneven ground
- Sun stroke and/or heat exhaustion
- Falling over edge of benches or drop-offs

- Sticking someone or being struck by a pick
- Being hit by a falling rock

- Site rules to be followed:
- You MUST comply with all reasonable instructions given by staff.
- You MUST wear fully closed in footwear at all times.
- You MUST Obey all danger and warning signs
- Do Not go beyond barricaded area at any time you will be removed from the mine.
- Do Not crack open any Thundereggs on the mine site – you will be removed from the mine.
- Do Not undertake any activities in the mine if you are under the influence of alcohol or drugs

- Do Not go near or climb any banks, rock walls, drop offs or slopes
- Do Not dig into the slopes, embankments, tracks or sides of the tracks – you will be removed from the mine.
- Take reasonable precautions against sun stroke/burn etc by wearing a hat, applying sunscreen etc
- Take plenty of drinking water (available for sale)
- Remove hand rings and jewellery that may be a hazard when digging at the mine
- Children are to be supervised at all times

Fitness Assessment (Circle whichever answer applies)

- Do you have any medical condition (e.g. Asthma, diabetes, angina) that could require emergency medication whilst on site? YES / NO
