## Legislative Requirements and Conditions

### Condition

#### Nature Conservation

CWM02

Accurate records of wildlife encountered during licenced activities must be kept as outlined in section 8 of the approved Interaction Plan. These must be made at the end of each day/night.

The records must be made available for inspection by a departmental officer upon request.

CWM03

The permit holder must deliver any animal suffering from an injury or illness to a veterinarian or licenced wildlife carer within 72 hours for assessment and rehabilitation.

CWM05

The record must include information about the activities carried out under the licence and identify problems or concerns relating to animals or clients involved in the activities, for example:

1. any increase in illness or injury in the animals,
2. any incidence of aggression by animals against holder's clients participating in the activities,
3. any complaint by a member of the public about the impacts of the activity and how these problems or concerns were identified and resolved.
